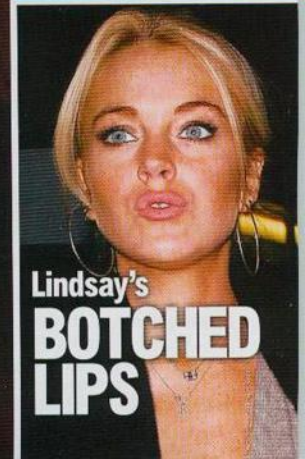

Sitting in her suite at the Four Seasons Hotel in Beverly Hills, Britney

Spears phoned a friend with shocking news. "Britney was hysterical," the pal tells *In Touch*. "She told me she had taken a pregnancy test — and that it was positive."

Four days later, on November 14, Britney also confided to other friends in e-mails that she was four weeks pregnant — and that she was sure the father was J.R. Rotem, a music producer she's been seeing on and off since she separated from ex-husband Kevin Federline in 2006. When asked about the pregnancy, J.R. confirmed

exclusively to *In Touch* that Britney was carrying his child. "It's true," he says.

Britney, 25, was not planning to have another baby. "She was shocked," a confidant tells *In Touch*. But on November 16, she proudly e-mailed a copy of the ultrasound to her inner circle. "Friends who know about it are in disbelief,"

an insider says. "It's crazy." A close pal of Kevin's says he is "happy" for J.R.: "All we can say is good luck with that."

Is she stable enough?

Britney plans to keep J.R.'s baby, the insider adds, even though she recently lost custody of her two sons, Sean Preston, 2, and Jayden, 14 months, to Kevin, 29, and

cannot visit the boys without the supervision of a court-appointed parenting monitor.

Close friends of Britney's family say her estranged mother, Lynne Spears, is not happy about the news — for good reason. "It is highly irresponsible for her to be having another child," Dr. Judith B. Kuriansky, a psychologist for CNN

Headline News' *Showbiz Tonight*, who does not treat Britney, tells *In Touch*.

"It would complicate the horrible situation she's already put her other two children in. They have not been treated well and both of their parents are in conflict. Nobody in a mature state of mind would get pregnant at this stage of her parenting,



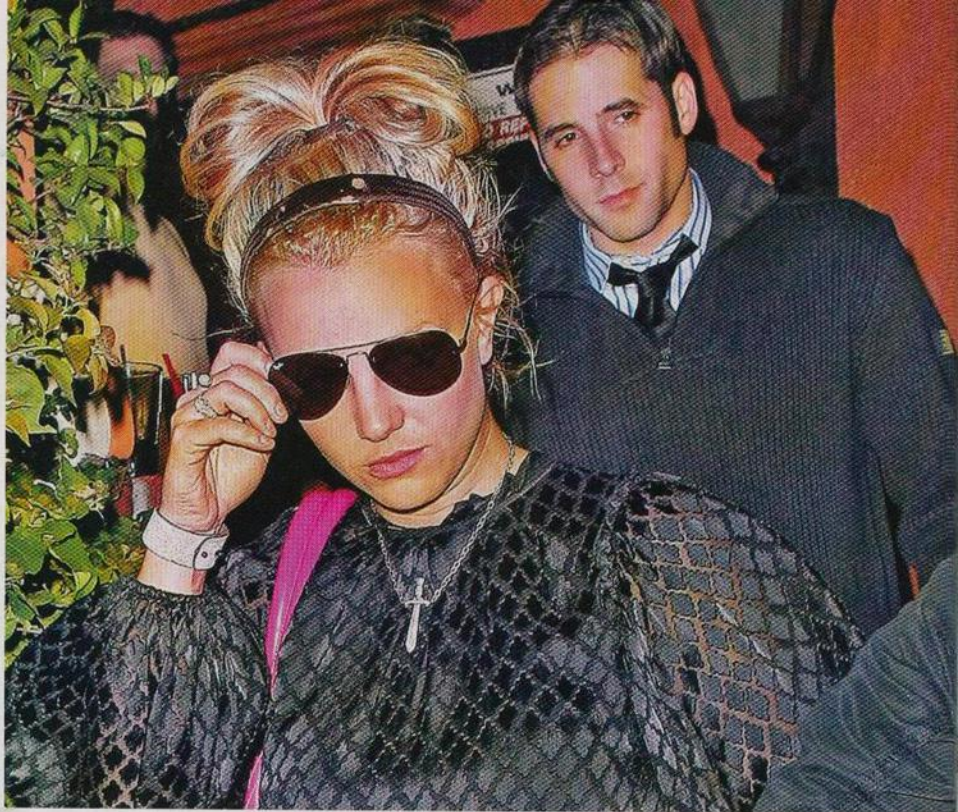
J.R. Rotem is the daddy

After separating from Kevin in late 2006, Britney dated J.R., who produced tracks on both of their albums, for two weeks. Although Britney and J.R. split, and he spilled juicy details about their relationship in interviews, they started to see each other again recently. "She's not in love with J.R. and she doesn't want to get married again so soon," a pal says. "But she knows he would make a great father to their baby."



How does her new man feel about it?

Now that Britney is pregnant with J.R.'s baby, she might have some explaining to do to her new boyfriend, Michael Marchand, a waiter at LA restaurant Mirabelle. "They started dating in early November," a friend says, but adds that they aren't serious. Another pal adds, "J.R. loves Britney. He wants to marry her."



She spent the holiday alone

Britney spent time with Sean, Jayden and a parenting monitor on November 21, but the next day the children went to Kevin's house for a Thanksgiving feast with his ex Shar Jackson and their kids. "They had turkey and homemade pies, while Britney was at the Four Seasons Hotel," an insider says. "She didn't even call."

Sadly, Britney is more than just immature. Insiders say she's a danger to her children — and herself — and apparently still has addiction issues. On November 20, she was drinking at Mirabelle in Hollywood, according to an insider. That same week, says an insider says, she failed two court-mandated drug tests when her blood showed traces of amphetamines. An insider close to Britney says the result was a false-positive caused by prescription medications. But a pal tells *In Touch* that Britney has promised to tame her wild ways: "She will not jeopardize the health of her unborn baby by partying."

It's hard to believe that Britney's tumultuous lifestyle is appropriate for a newborn, but legally, no one can stop her from becoming a mom again. "There are no pregnancy police," family law attorney John Harding, who does not represent Britney, tells *In Touch*. "The judge in her current case does not have any authority to issue court orders about a child that is not a product of Britney and Kevin's relationship. But once the child is born, Child Protection Services have a duty to investigate any complaints of abuse or neglect."

She wants a baby girl

For all of her recent troubles, Britney seems convinced that having another baby will turn her life around — and she believes that J.R., 32, will make a great father, even though he explicitly talked about their sex life in *Blender* magazine earlier this year. "Britney's not looking for another husband," an insider says. "But she does like having a man in her life."

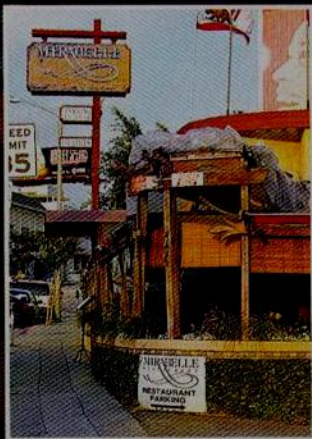
Britney's not sure of the sex of the baby yet, but knows what she wants. "She's obsessed with having a little girl," a pal says. "She won't be happy unless it's a girl."

She's still drinking

Britney was spotted sipping wine and what looked like strawberry daiquiris at Mirabelle in Hollywood on November 20. Drinking during pregnancy can lead to birth defects or fetal alcohol syndrome in newborns.



No more lipo treatments

Less than a week before Britney found out she was pregnant, she had a LipoDissolve treatment performed. Experts say plastic surgery is very dangerous to a fetus. "General anesthesia during the first trimester can have severe effects mentally and neurologically," says Dr. Stuart Linder, who does not treat Britney and is the author of *The Beverly Hills Shape: The Truth About Plastic Surgery*. "Liposuction must never be performed on a pregnant woman at any time. It can lead to a miscarriage."
