

# Teen Mom Farrah's BOOB JOB!

The financially strapped single mother splurges on herself — and triples her breast size with surgery.

**F**ANS of *Teen Mom* have watched Farrah Abraham's life change drastically this season — she reconciled with her mother, came to terms with the death of her baby's father and struggled to pay her rent. But there's one aspect of her life the cameras didn't catch: a breast augmentation that took her from an A cup to a C cup!

An insider close to Farrah tells *Star* the 19-year-old mother and part-time model went under the knife on Sept. 9 to enlarge her chest size in her hometown of Council Bluffs, Iowa.

"It appears that she's had a breast



augmentation," NYC plastic surgeon Dr. Michael A. Fiorillo tells *Star*. "You can tell by the fullness in the after picture. She most likely had silicone implants as they are very natural looking." Another surgeon, Beverly Hills-based Dr. Stuart Linder, agrees that it seems Farrah has had implants, noting she was "quite flat," in the before photo, which was taken seven days before her surgery, on Sept. 2, while Farrah was in NYC to film the *Teen Mom* reunion. Now "She appears to have more upper-breast fullness," adds Dr. Linder, who has also not treated the reality star.

Farrah, a culinary student who works at a pizza parlor, has certainly struggled financially this season — at one point, she had only \$100 in her bank account to last her and daughter Sophia, 20 months, 30 days. Yet somehow she managed to afford the surgery, which can run as high as \$10,000. Her *Teen Mom* salary was reported on Oct. 5 to be \$45,000 for the season (\$5,000 per each of the nine episodes). Still, Dr. Linder says Farrah's surgery was worth every penny. "Her overall results are good, and the implant size is proportional for her body type and frame." ★
